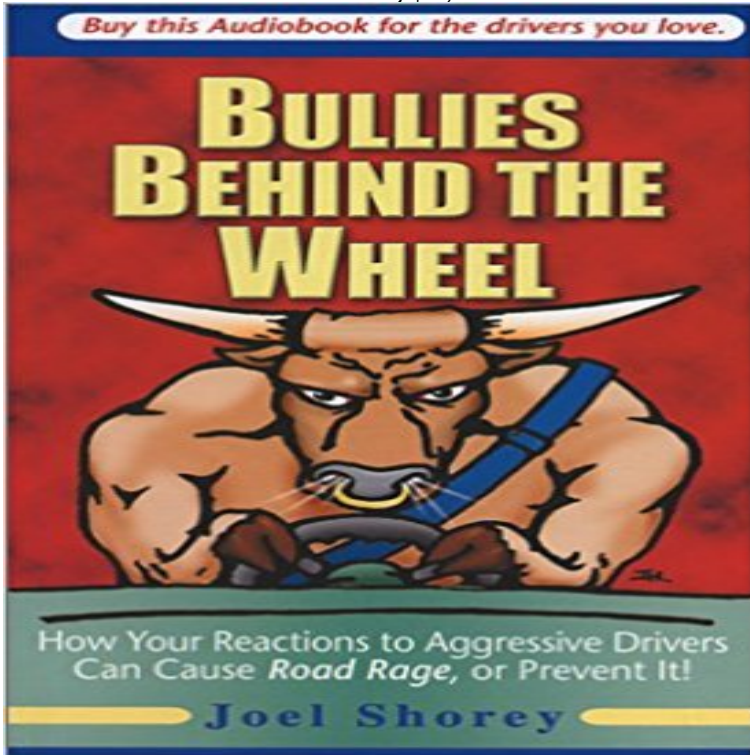


Bullies Behind the Wheel: How Your Reactions to Aggressive Drivers Can Cause Road Rage, or Prevent It
