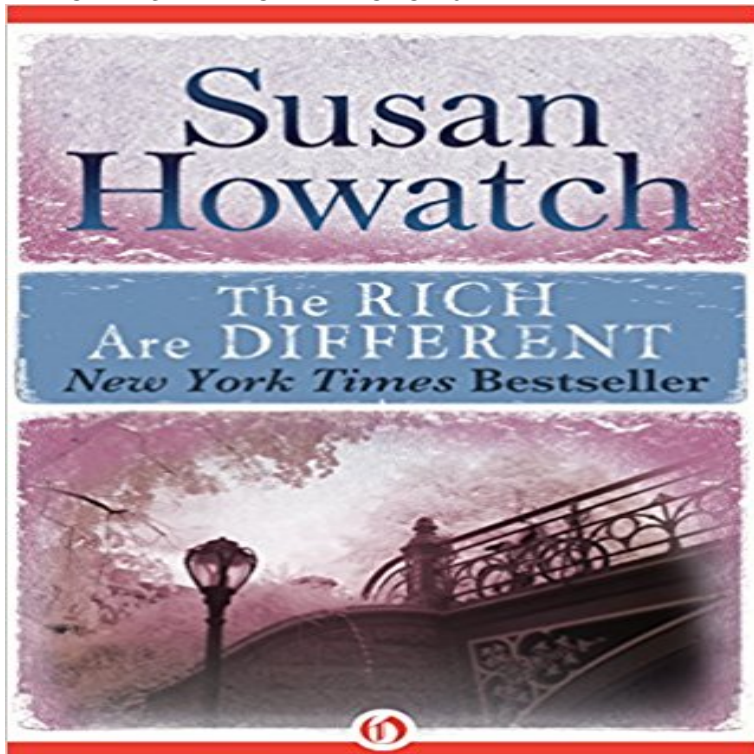


The Rich Are Different
