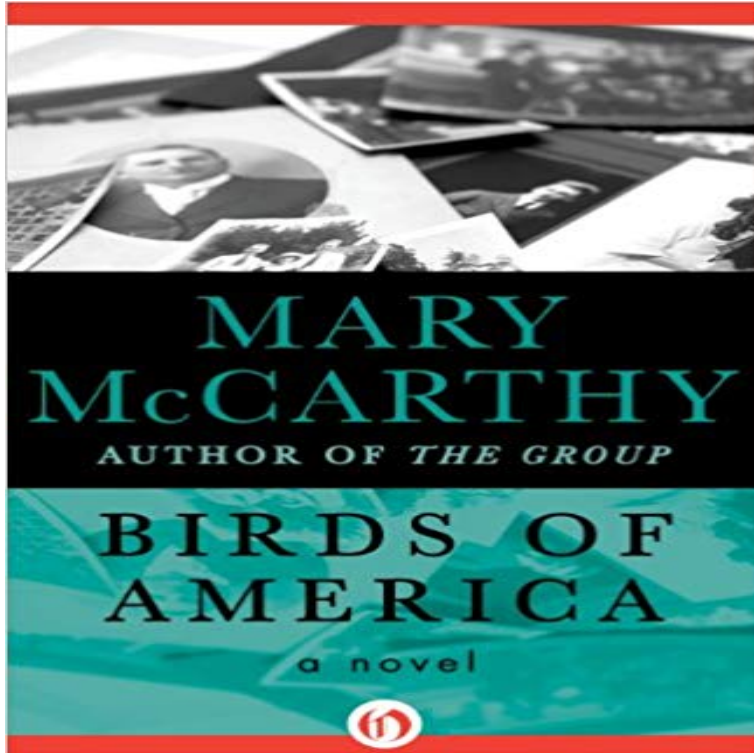


Birds of America: A Novel
