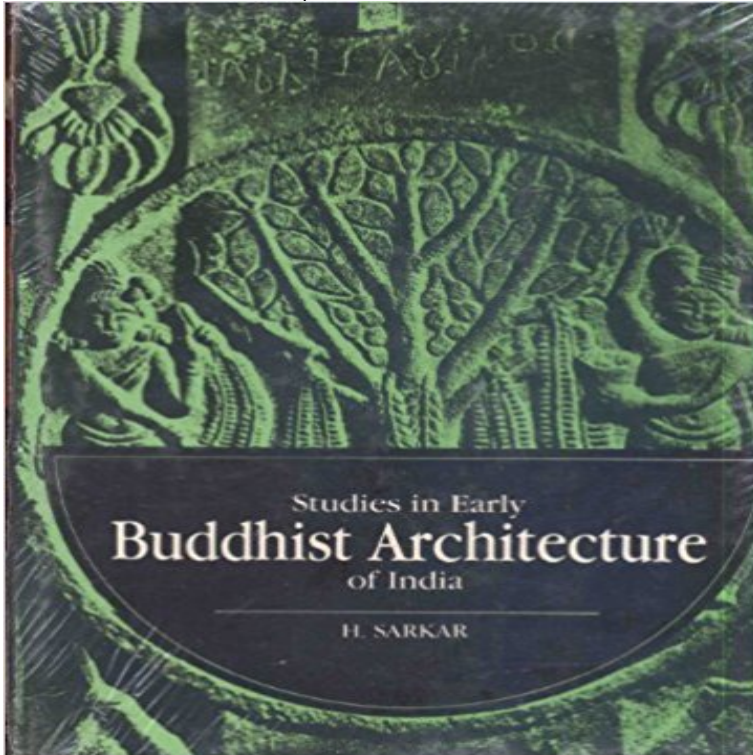


Studies in Early Buddhist Architecture of India
