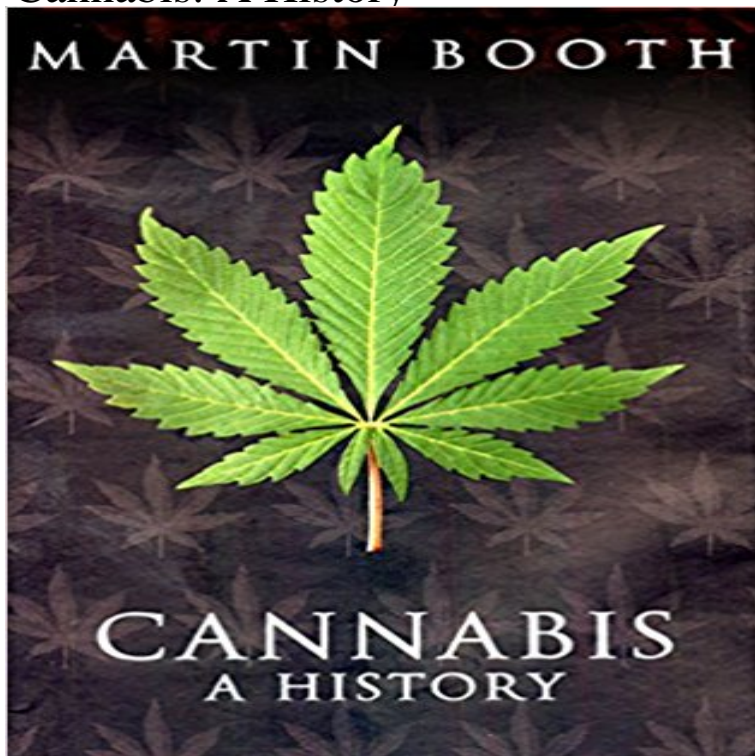


Cannabis: A History
