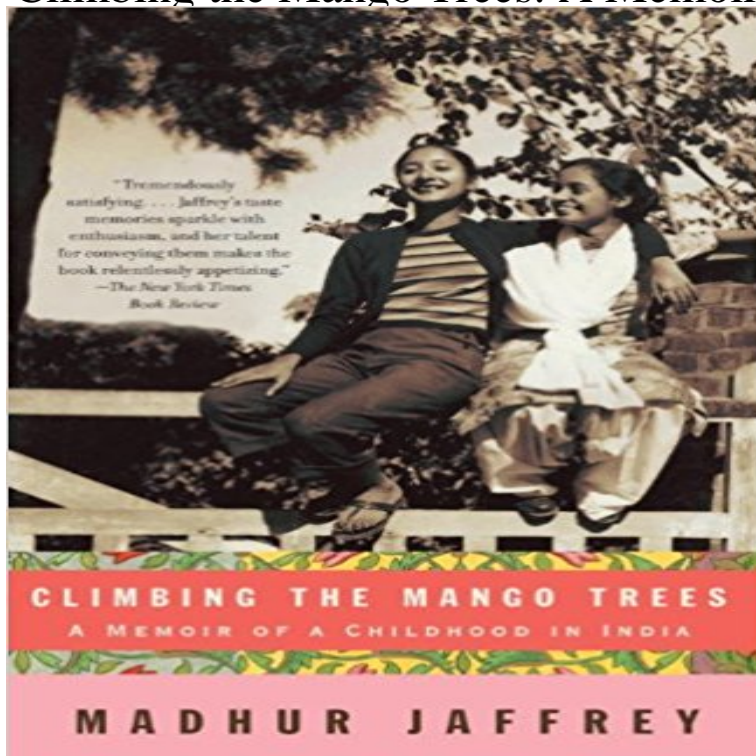


Climbing the Mango Trees: A Memoir of a Childhood in India
