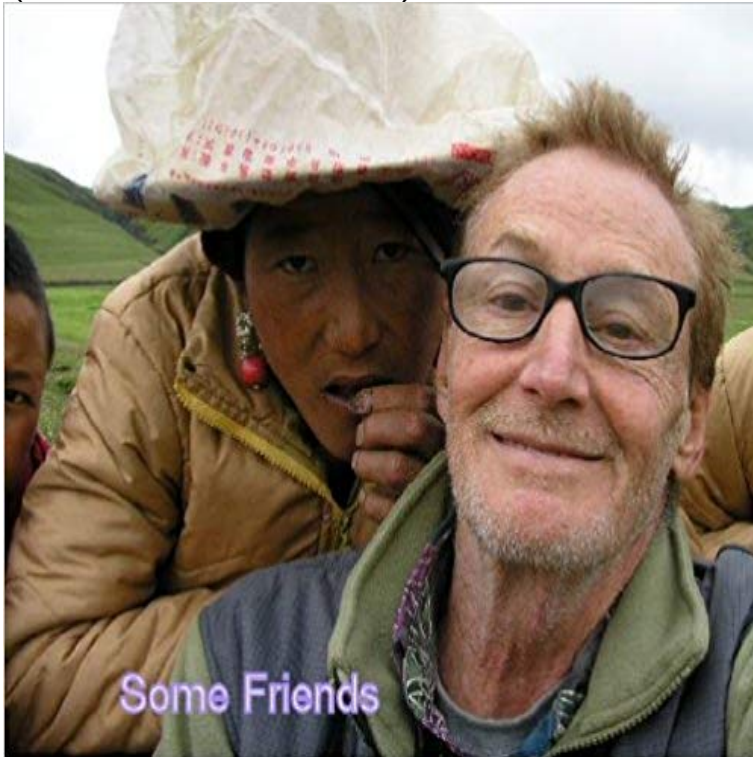


Becoming an Expatriate: First Four Months in China and Tibet (Adventures in Asia)



The author, encountering a mid-life crisis, travels to Asia to begin a new life as an American expatriate. This series is being published out of order, *Inside Burma: a Trip to the Beach* having been published earlier due to its contemporary political salience. This piece is equally salient at the moment. It depicts, in the second half, the struggle in Tibet leading up to the present day self-immolation by monks there. Like the Burmese piece, this contains original and authentic inside photographs which would be hard to replicate today, in this case due to restrictions on travel there by the Chinese government. These photos depict a visit to a functioning Tibetan monastery during a seasonal festival. The first section of this piece offers insights about modern China, but the authors internal transformation is the conveying theme of the whole piece.
