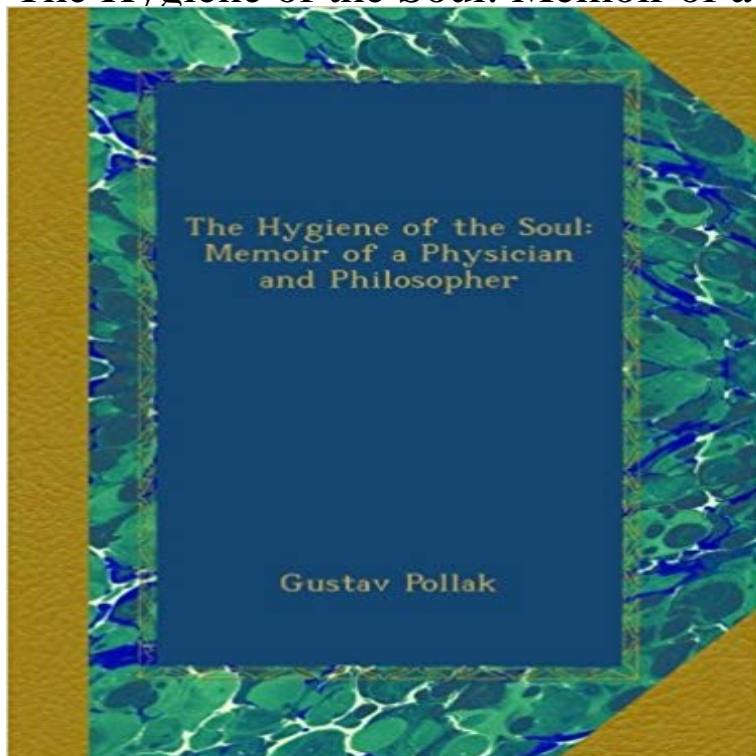


The Hygiene of the Soul: Memoir of a Physician and Philosopher
