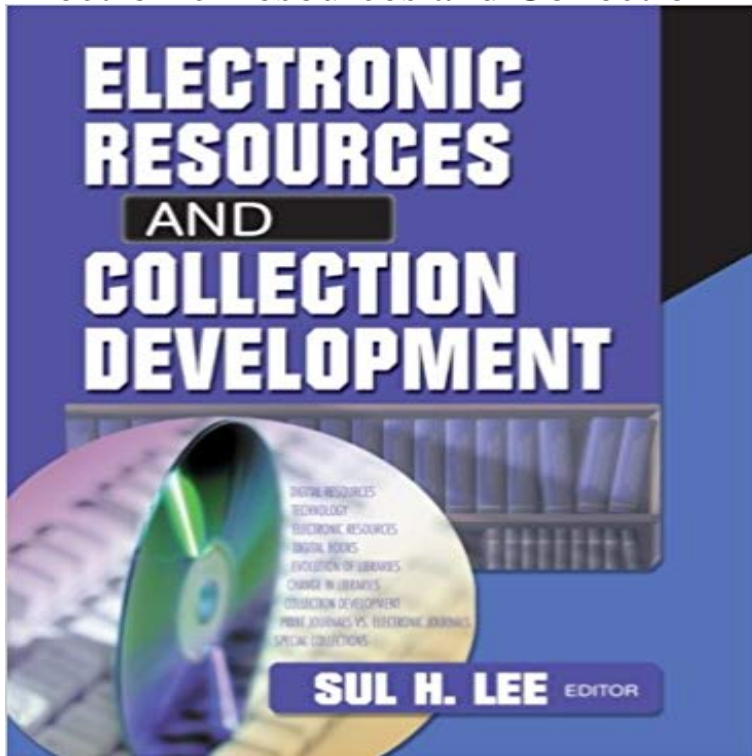


Electronic Resources and Collection Development
