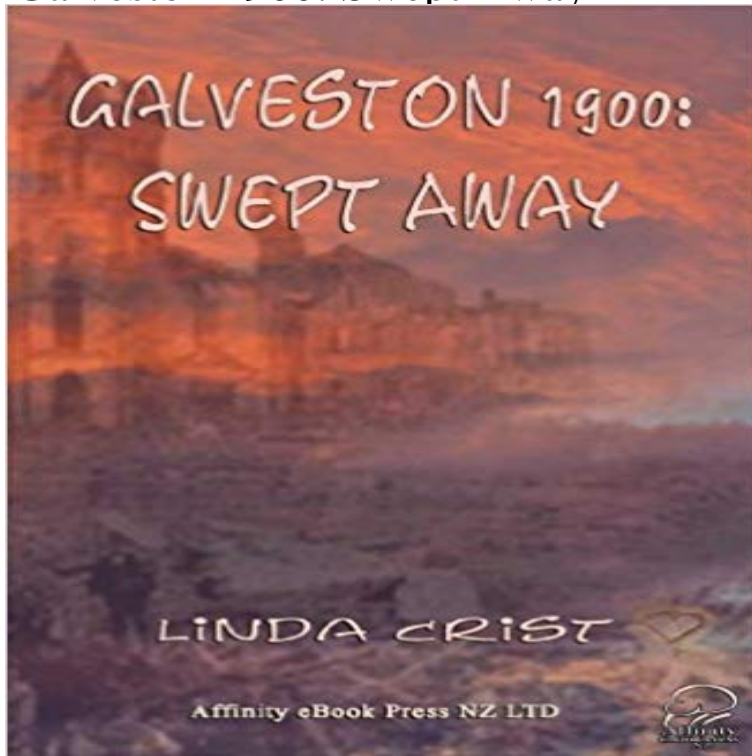


Galveston 1900: Swept Away
