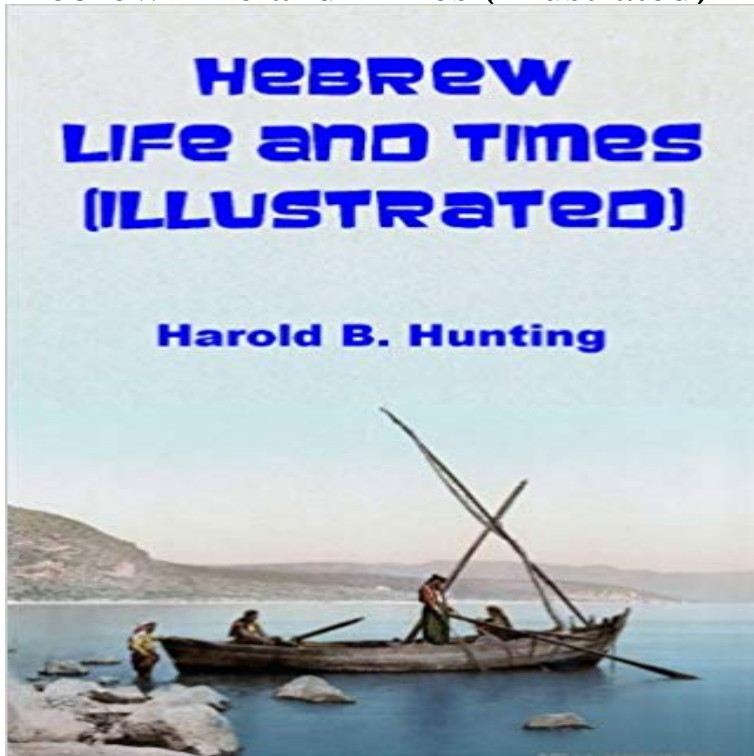

have been histories of kings and emperors.
The daily life of the common peopletheir
joys and sorrows, their hopes,
achievements, and idealshas been buried in
oblivion. The historical narratives of the
Bible are, indeed, to a great extent an
exception to this rule. They tell us much
about the everyday life of peasants and
slaves. The Bibles chief heroes were not
kings nor nobles. Its supreme Hero was a
peasant workingman. But we have not
always studied the Bible from this point of
view. In this course we shall try to
reconstruct for ourselves the story of the
Hebrew people as an account of Hebrew
shepherds, farmers, and such like: what
oppressions they endured; how they were
delivered; and above all what ideals of
righteousness and truth and mercy they
cherished, and how they came to think and
feel about God. It makes little difference to
us what particular idler at any particular
time sat in the palace at Jerusalem sending
forth tax-collectors to raise funds for his
luxuries. It is of very great interest and

concern to us if there were daughters like Ruth in the barley fields of Bethlehem, if shepherds tended their flocks in that same country who were so fine in heart and simple in faith that to them or their children ...
