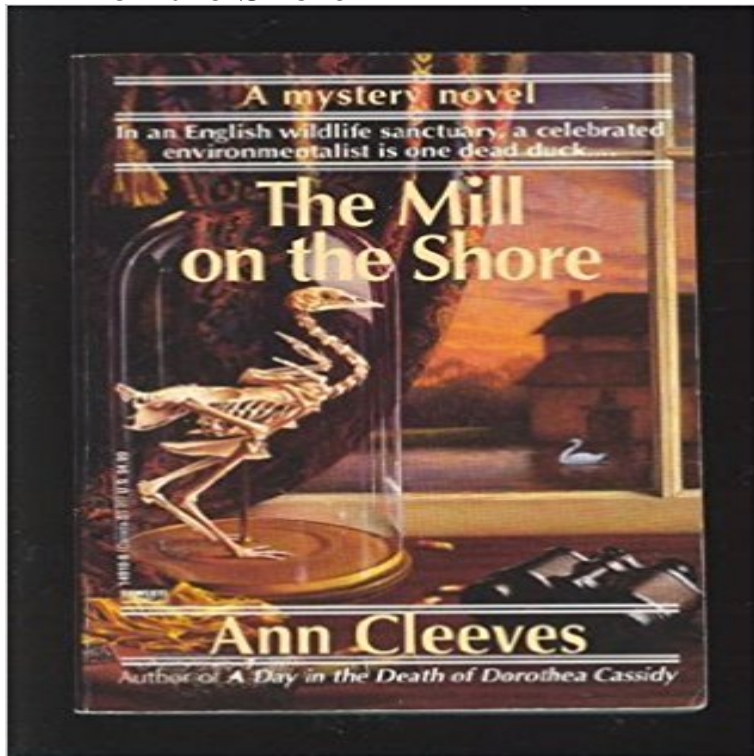


Mill on the Shore
