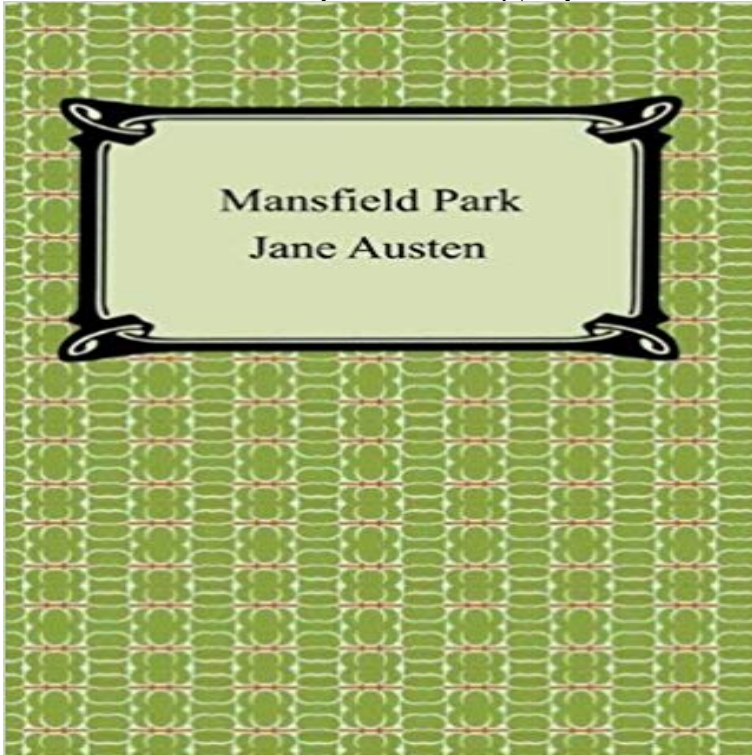


Mansfield Park [with Biographical Introduction]
