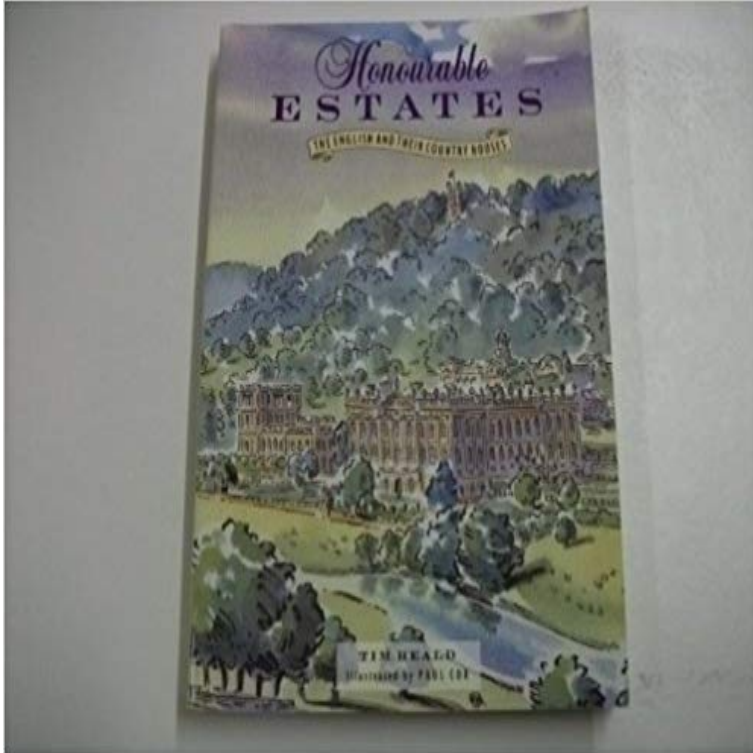


Honourable Estates: English and Their Country Houses
