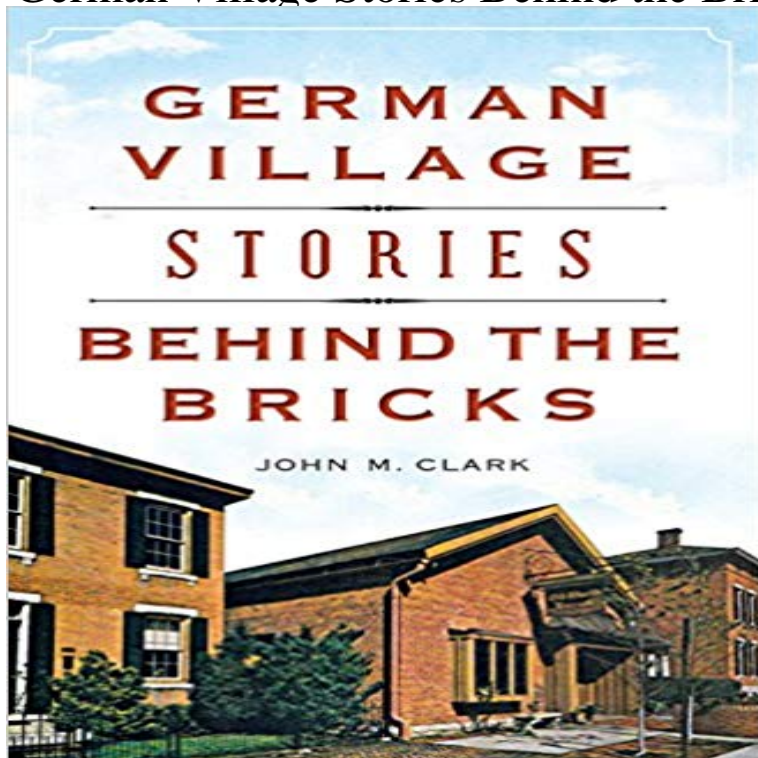


## German Village Stories Behind the Bricks (Landmarks)
