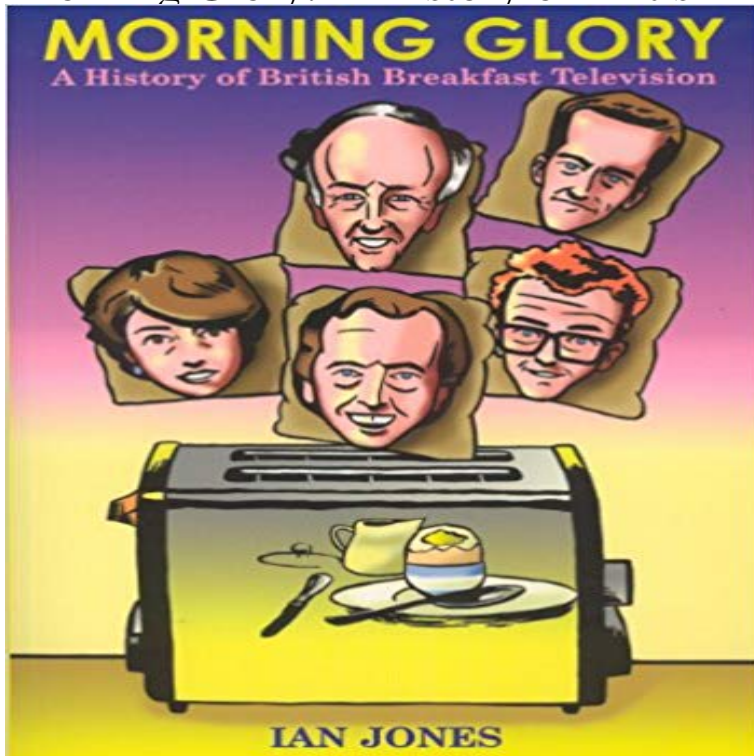


Morning Glory: A History of British Breakfast Television



IAN JONES traces the first twenty years of a genre that has revolutionised the landscape of contemporary TV. From the early days of TV-am and Breakfast Time, through the turbulent arrival of The Big Breakfast and GMTV, to the messy death of Rise, the book documents the twists and turns of a story unique in broadcasting for its high-profile triumphs and disasters, raging egos and scandalous bust-ups. Featuring major interviews by the author with the key figures that shaped the course of breakfast TV both in front of and behind the camera (such as Greg Dyke, John Stapleton and Nick Ross), the book also includes extensive research into previously undocumented episodes of television history. The end result is the fullest account of the birth, development and ongoing influence of breakfast television ever written. Authoritative, humorous, packed with anecdotes and boasting a series of superb original illustrations by Graham Kibble-White, MORNING GLORY is a sweeping and hugely entertaining tribute to an important piece of television history.
