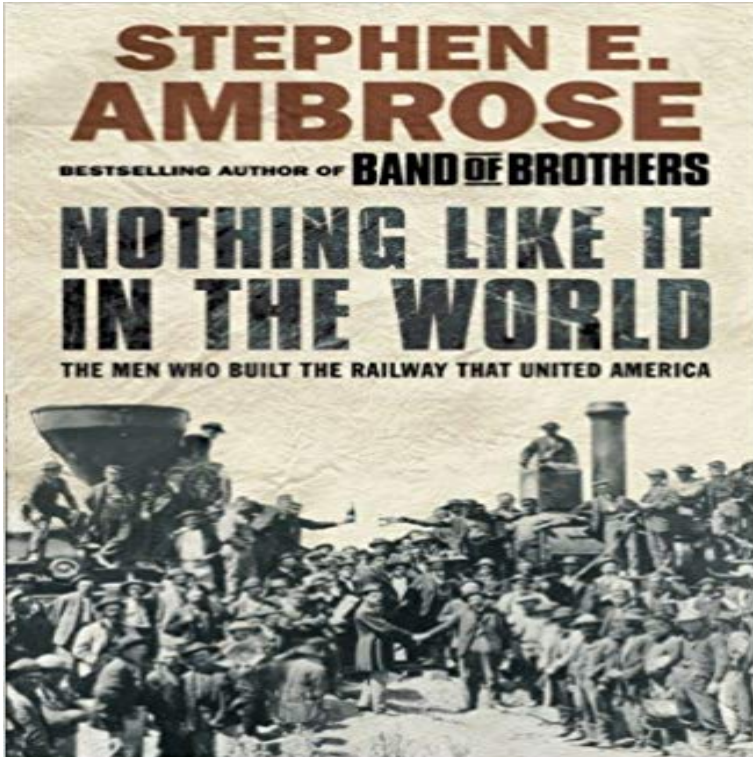


Nothing Like It in the World: The Men Who Built the Railway That United America
