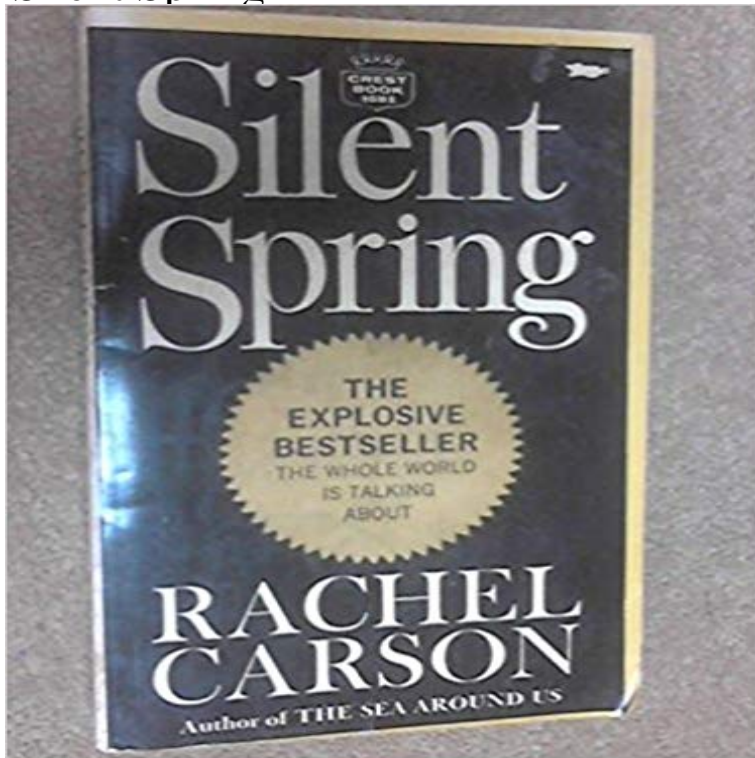


Silent Spring
