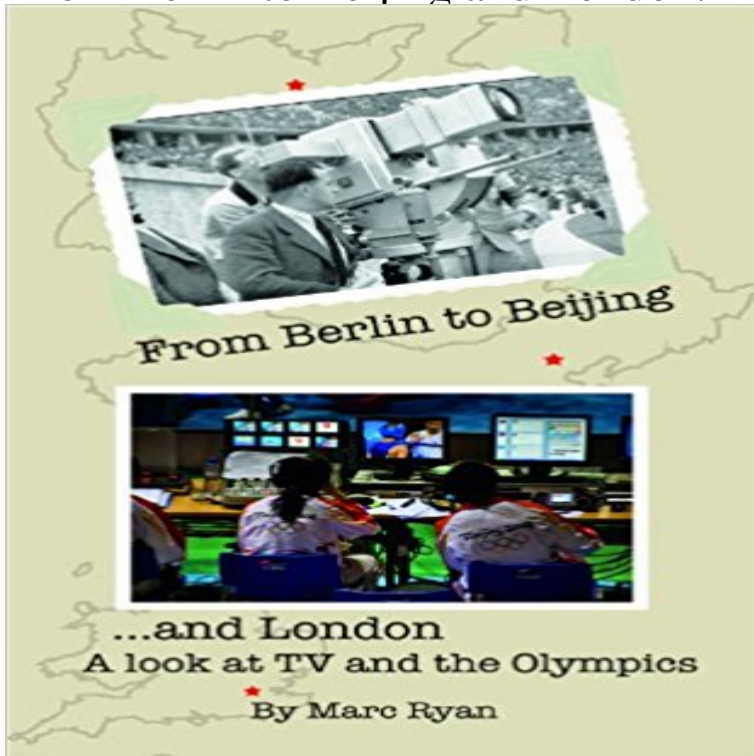


From Berlin to Beijing and London: A Look at TV & the Olympics
