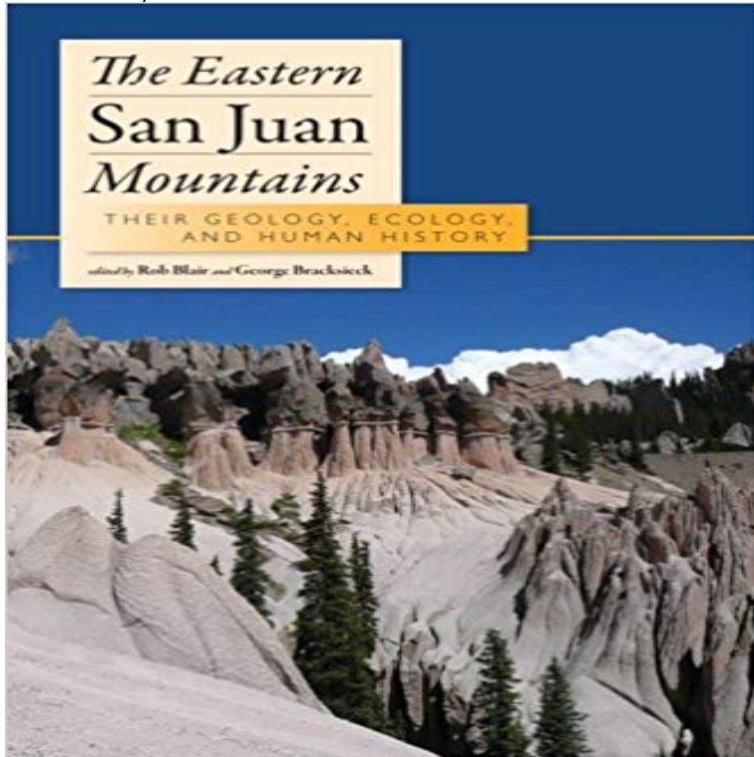


The Eastern San Juan Mountains: Their Ecology, Geology, and Human History
