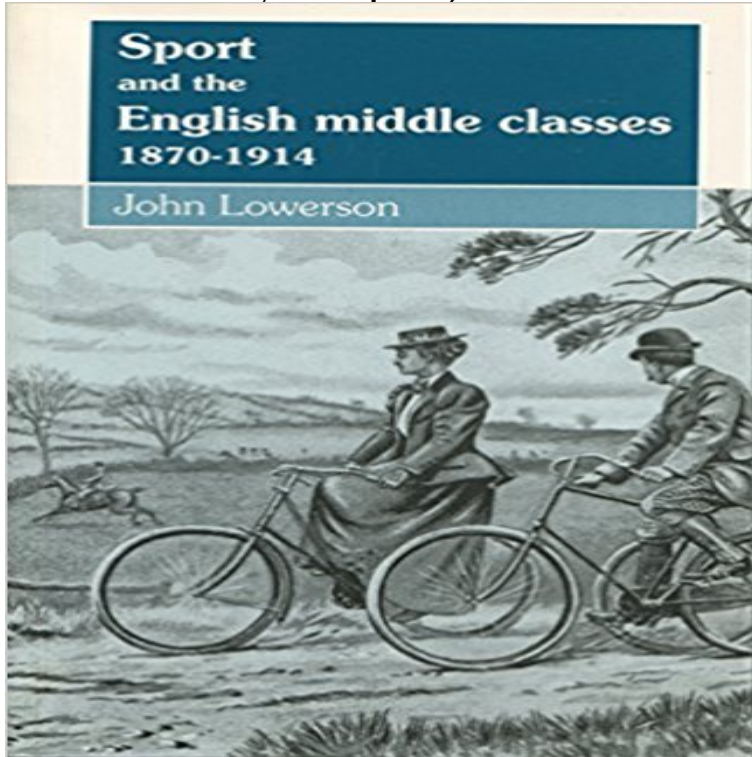


Sport and the English Middle Classes, 1870-1914 (International Studies in the History of Sport)

The author focuses on the extent to which sport became an agent of the development of the middle classes and an instrument of their self-definition. The book does not set out to explain the making of the English middle classes; rather, it examines a significant part of that making.
