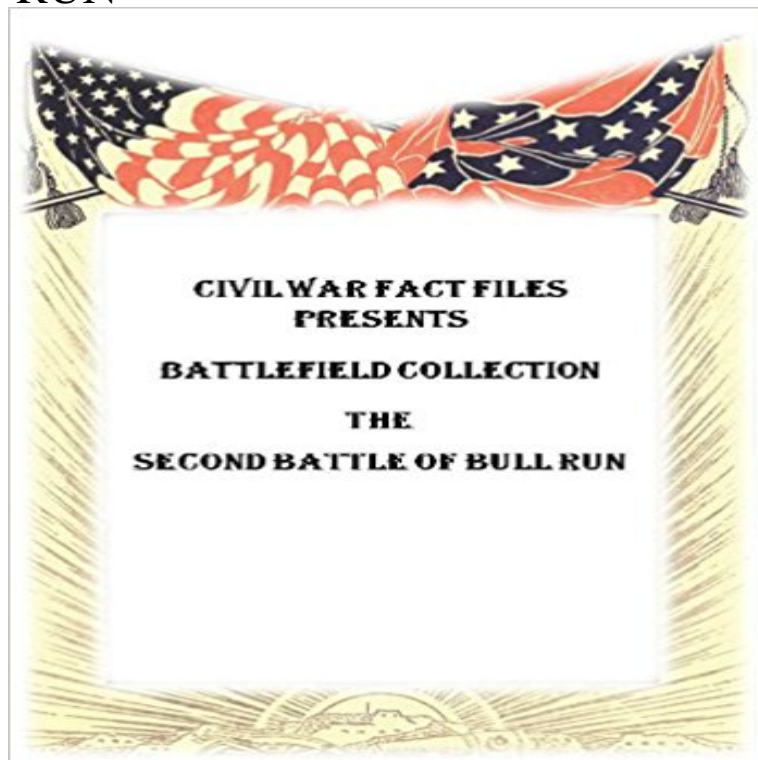

The three weeks intervening between the battles of Cedar Mountain and Second Bull Run were spent in heavy skirmishing and getting position for a decisive battle. General Popes headquarters was at Culpeper Court House, but he had left much of his personal baggage and private papers at Catletts Station, on the Orange and Alexandria railroad, while his vast store of supplies was at Manassas Junction. Pope was expecting to be reinforced by McClellan, but they had not yet arrived. Meanwhile Lee had sent Longstreet with his corps to reinforce Jackson, and followed up later himself. Longstreet reached Gordonsville on the 13th day of August. Lee observed that Popes position was weak at Culpeper and determined to attack him without delay and gave orders for his army to cross the Rapidan. Pope knew that his position at Culpeper was weak and fell back to a stronger position behind the Rappahannock.
