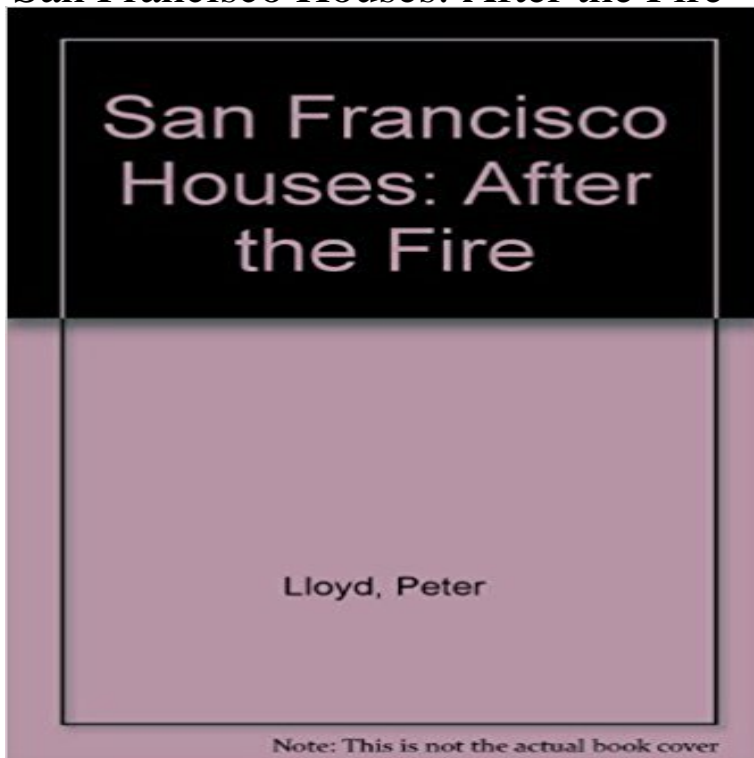


San Francisco Houses: After the Fire
