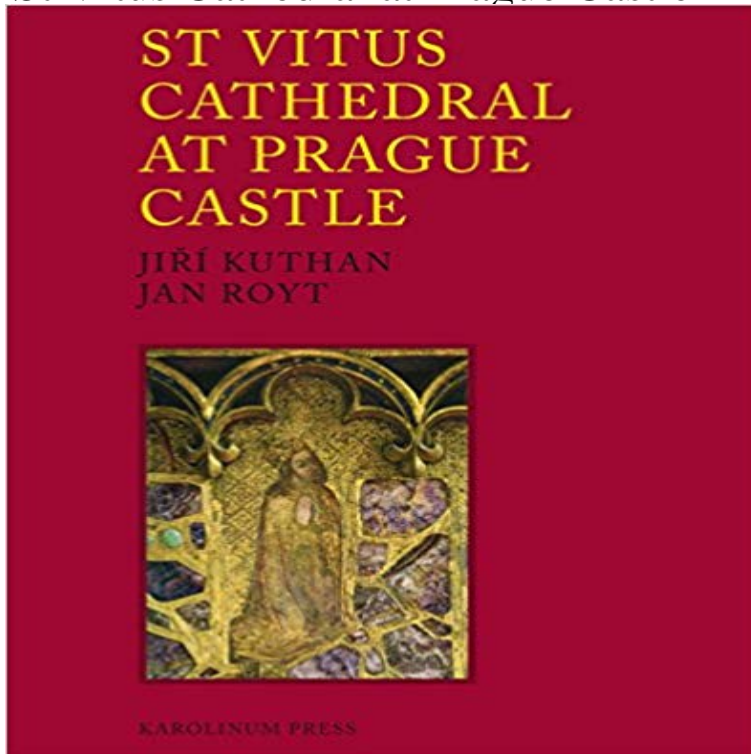


St Vitus Cathedral at Prague Castle
