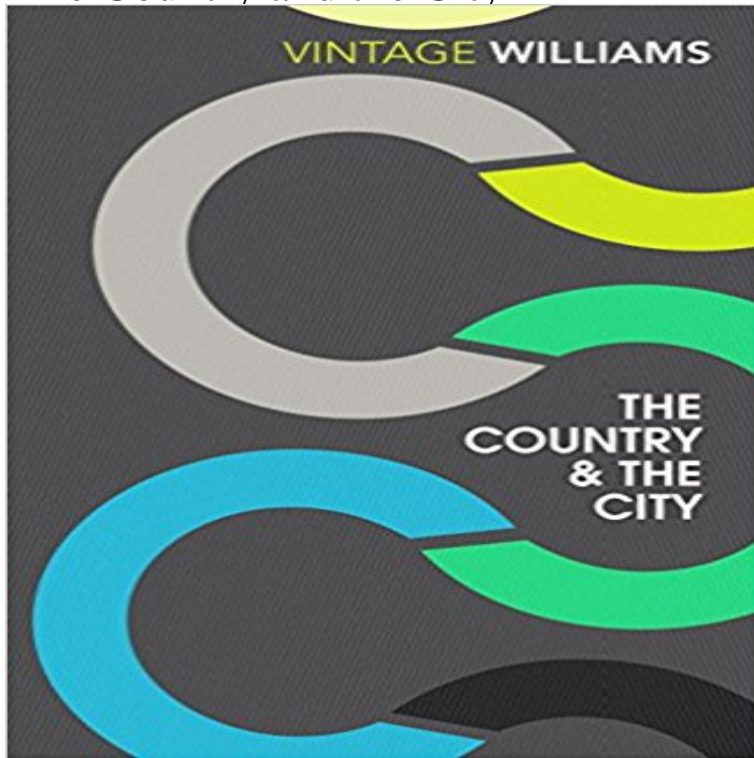


The Country and the City
