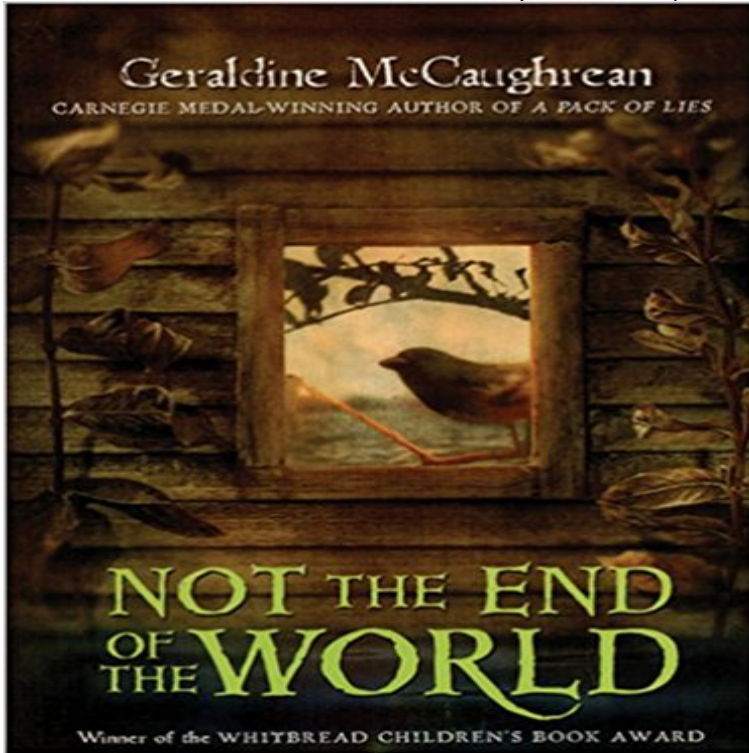


Not the End of the World (Literacy Bridge Young Adult)
