
The Fragility Of Empathy After The Holocaust

Does an excess of terror place constraints on compassion?Dean examines the different representations of suffering found in visual media, history writing, cultural criticism, and journalism that grapple with the assumption that Americans and Western Europeans have been rendered numb and their appropriate responses blunted by the events of the past century.
