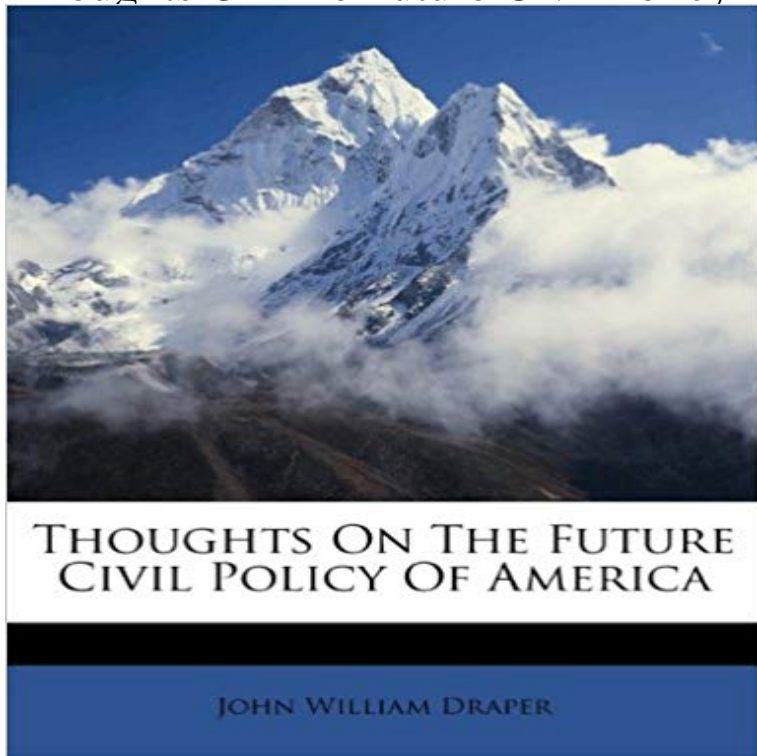


Thoughts On The Future Civil Policy Of America
